## 'EASY VOTER CARD' TO ASSIST WILLAGEE ELECTORS

The WA Electoral Commission is producing an elector information guide or 'Easy Voter Card' to assist Willagee electors in having their say in the forthcoming November 28<sup>th</sup> by-election.

The Easy Voter Card will be mailed directly to electors on the roll for the Willagee District from Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> November.

The card provides electors with details of how to complete their ballot papers correctly and a map showing the location of all polling places in the district, including those polling places most suitable for electors with a disability and the drive-in polling place for electors with mobility problems.

For electors who will be out of the district or unable to attend a district polling place on polling day the easy voter card also has details of how to obtain a postal vote or where to vote early in person.

Willagee electors are encouraged to take the easy voter card with them when they go to cast their vote on Saturday 28<sup>th</sup> November – it will help ensure their vote counts and make voting quick and easy.

The card is similar to that delivered to all households during the 2008 State general election, but this time it is specifically addressed to the individual elector.

Electors in the District of Willagee are reminded that voting in the by-election is compulsory.
