



# Application for registration as:

- a general postal voter for federal elections; and
- general early voter for Western Australian State elections



## Who can register as a general postal voter?

You are eligible to register as a general postal voter if you are already enrolled and can satisfy one of the options listed at item 7. Please note that the last two options at item 7 apply only to federal elections.

## Persons unable to sign

If you are unable to sign your name or vote in the ordinary way, you can register as a general postal voter for federal elections using this form. For Western Australian State elections it is a requirement that the person signing on behalf of the applicant, sign the name of the applicant at item 8.

## General postal voting at federal elections

Electors who are registered as general postal voters will be sent ballot papers as soon as practicable after the declaration of nominations for a federal election, or the issue of writs for a federal referendum.

## General early voting at Western Australian State elections

Electors who are registered as general early voters will be sent ballot papers as soon as practicable after the declaration of nominations for a State election, or the issue of writs for a State referendum.

## Access to information

The Commonwealth register of general postal voters, listing the names and addresses of people registered, is available for public inspection in divisional offices during normal office hours.
