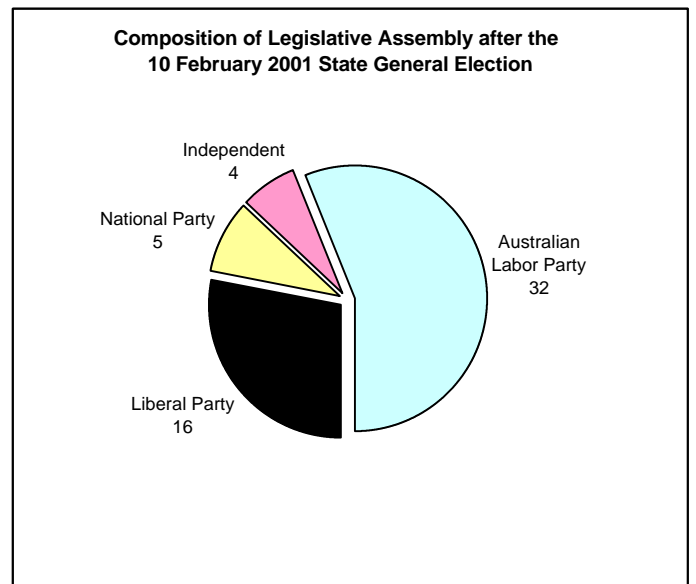
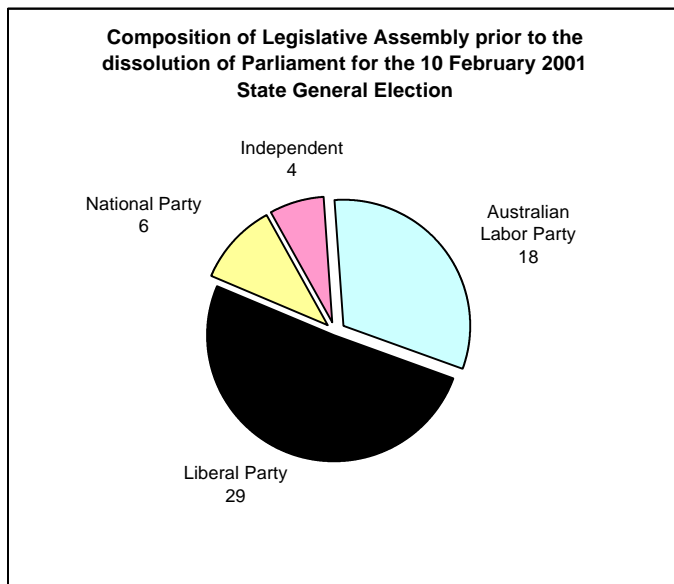

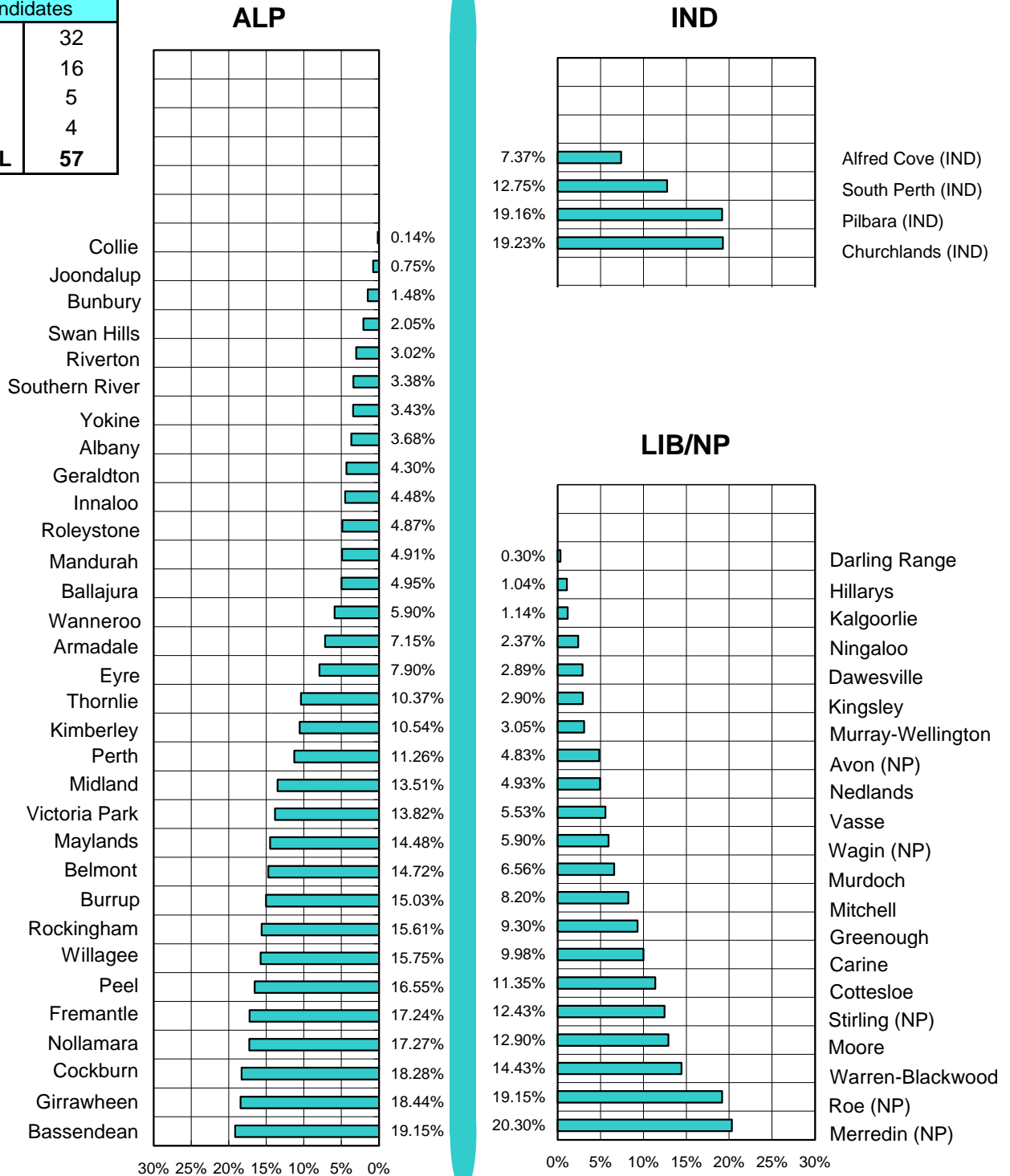
Balance of Power Prior to and After the 10 February 2001 State General Election

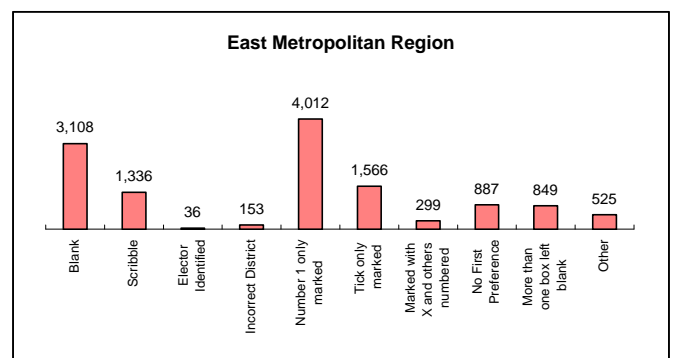
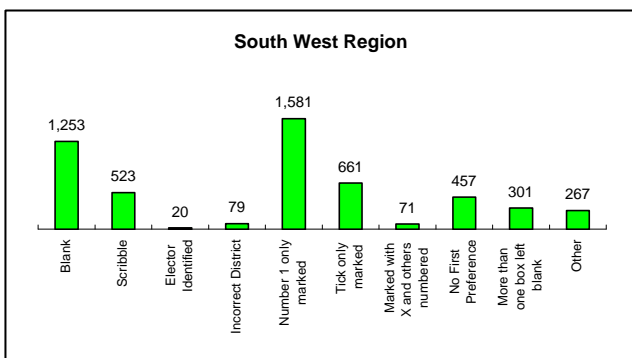
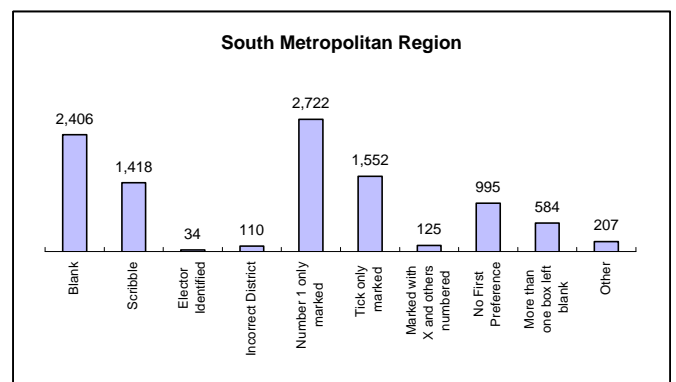
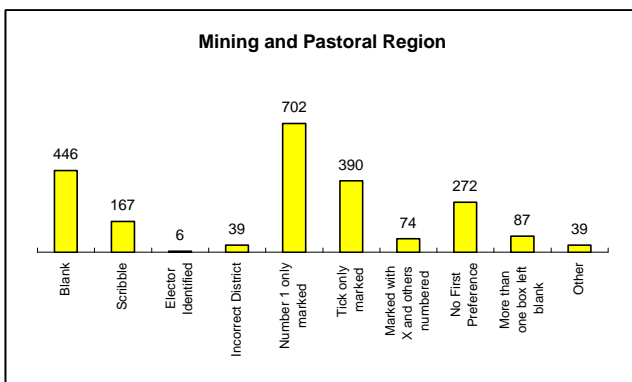
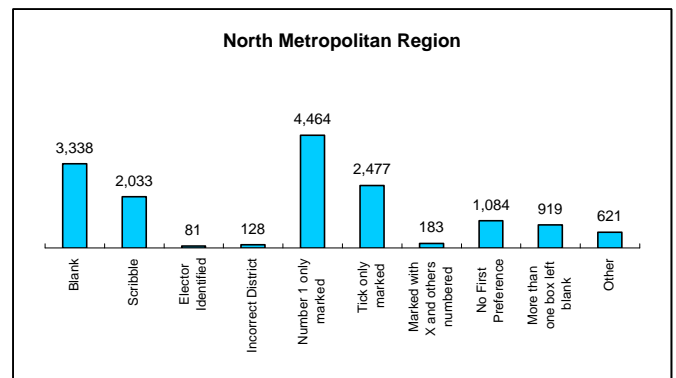
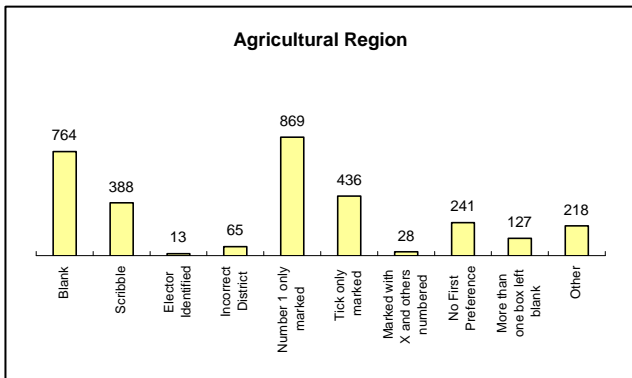
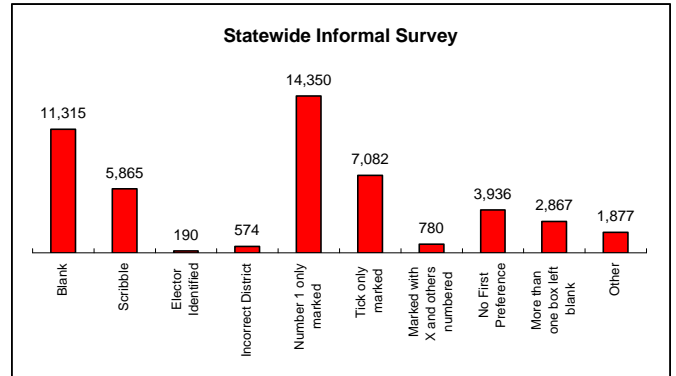
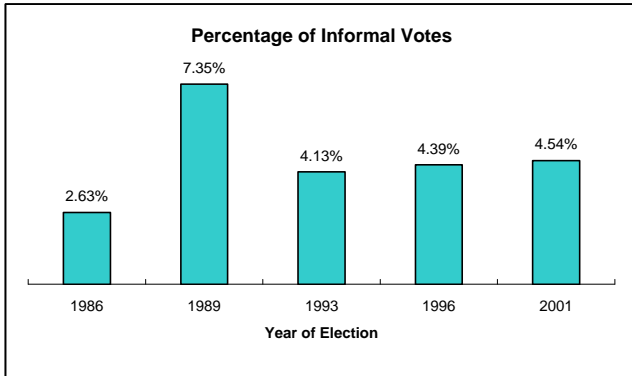
Legislative Assembly Informal Voting Summary

Informal Voting

Informal voting increased marginally in the Legislative Assembly. This was in spite of the fact that preferences were permitted to be counted until exhausted, provided all boxes were clearly marked.

Ballot papers which are blank, do not show preferences in accordance with instructions and/or legislative requirements, or do not make the voter's intention clear are classified as informal. A ballot paper will also be informal if the voter can be identified through a marking on it. Informal ballot papers do not contribute to the election of a candidate and are not included in calculating the quota or absolute majority required for election.

Blank ballot papers comprised 23% of the informal vote, and ballot papers which were scribbled on comprised 12%, so it would appear that at least 35% of the informal votes were intended to be so by the voters. The largest group of informal voters who registered a vote were those who indicated a first preference only (29%).

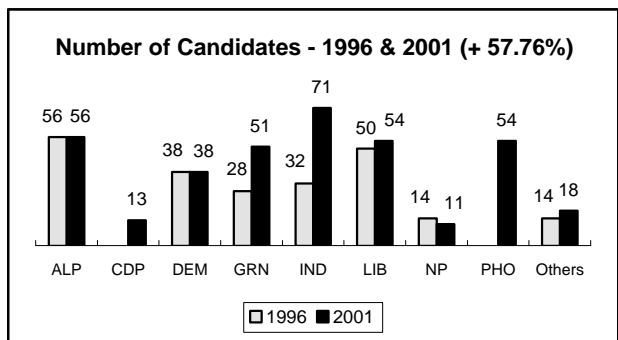
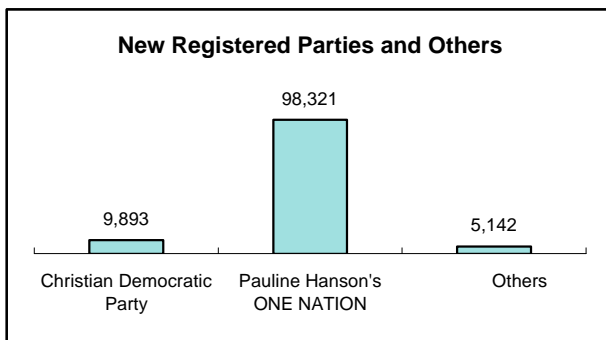
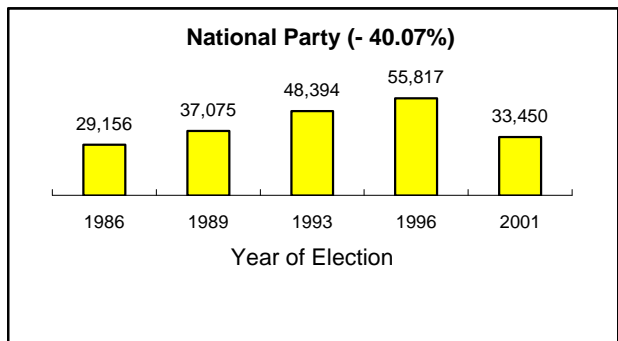
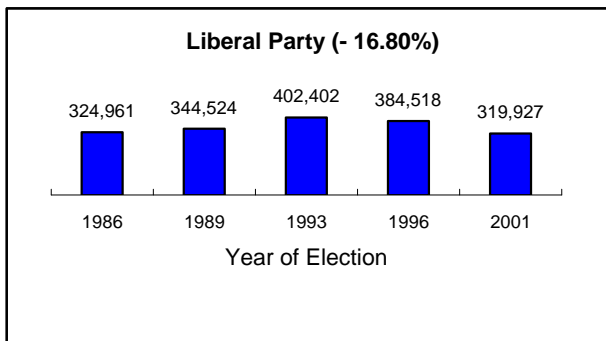
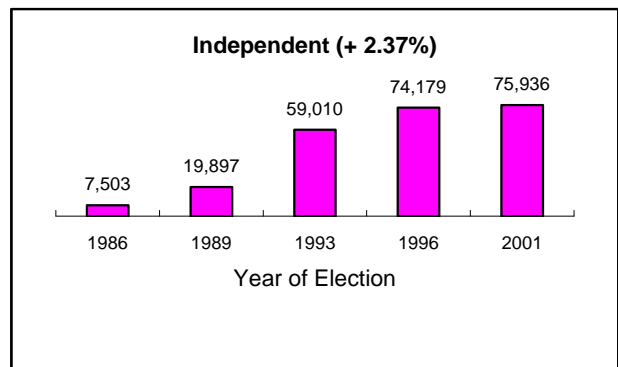
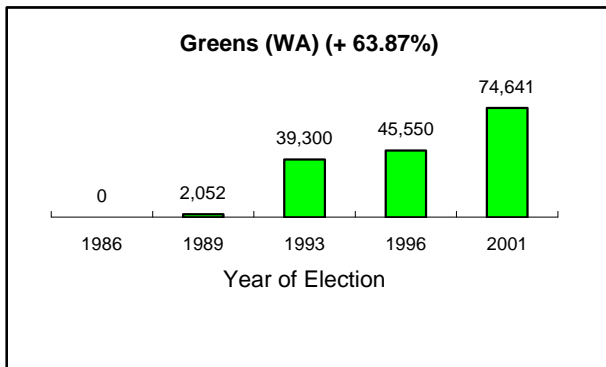
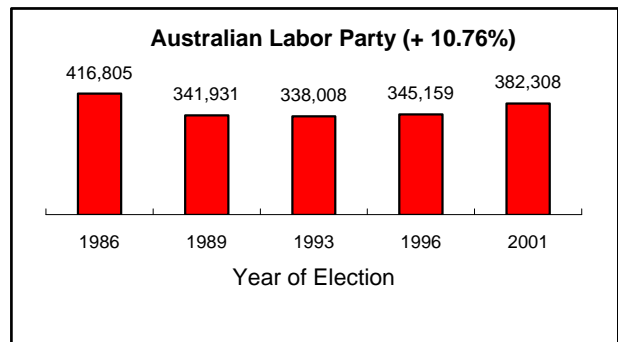
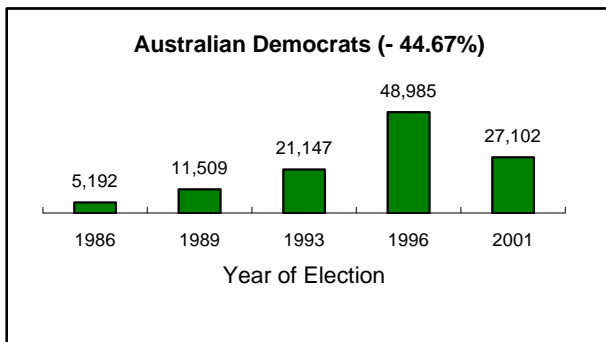
The Australian Labor Party recorded the highest increase in the number of first preference votes (37,149) compared with 1996, an increase of 10.76%.

The Greens (WA) recorded the highest increase in percentage of first preference votes compared with 1996, an increase of 63.87%. This may have been attributed to having 51 candidates in the 2001 compared with 28 in 1996.

The Coalition recorded the highest decrease in the number of first preference votes (86,958) compared with 1996, a decrease of 19.75%.

The Australian Democrats recorded the highest decrease in the percentage of first preference votes compared with 1996, a decrease of 44.67%.

Pauline Hanson's ONE NATION recorded 98,321 votes in their first election in Western Australia with 54 candidates. This represented 9.58% of the first preference votes statewide.

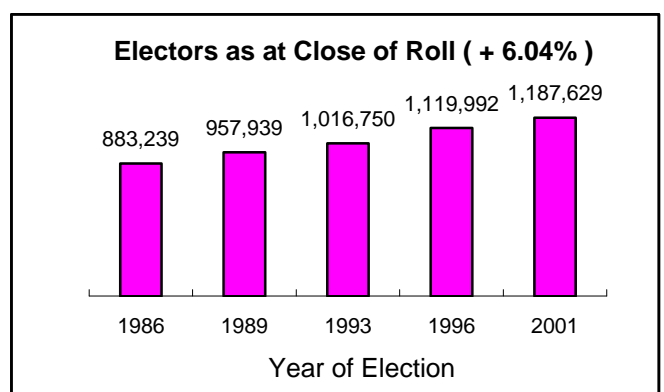
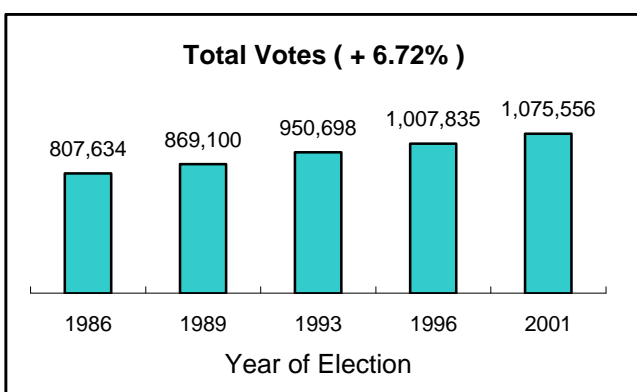
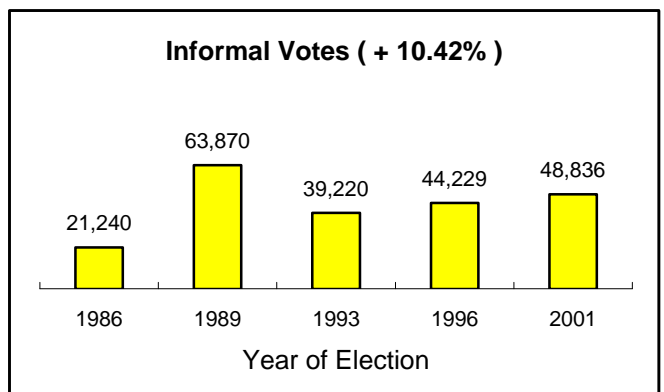
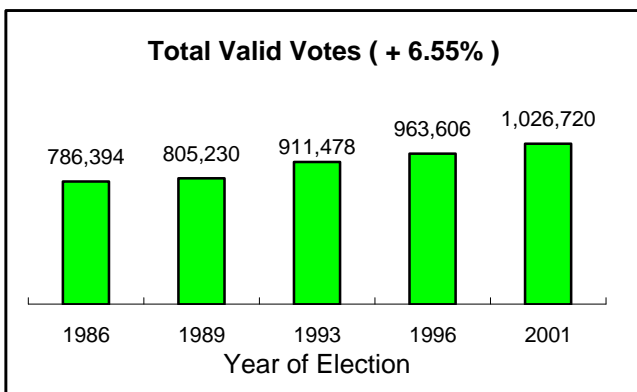
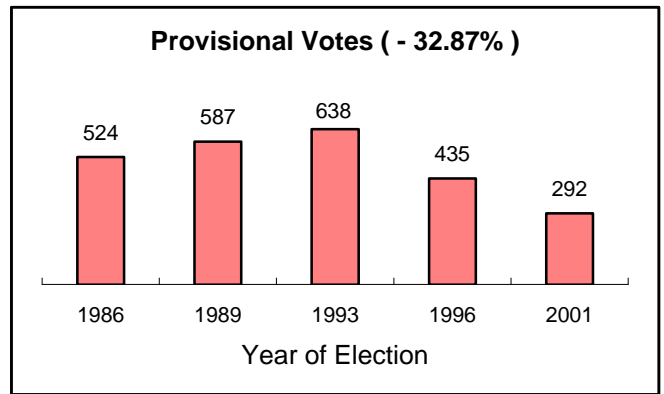
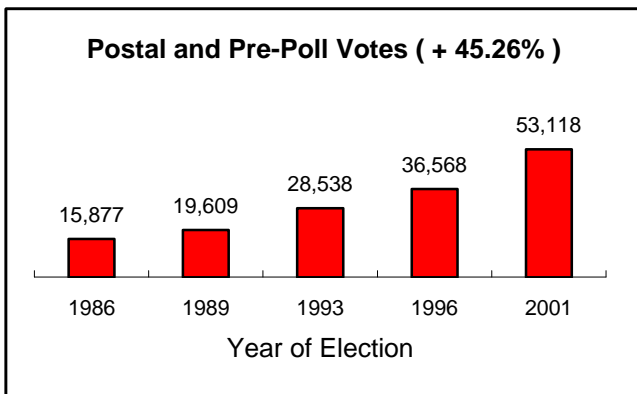
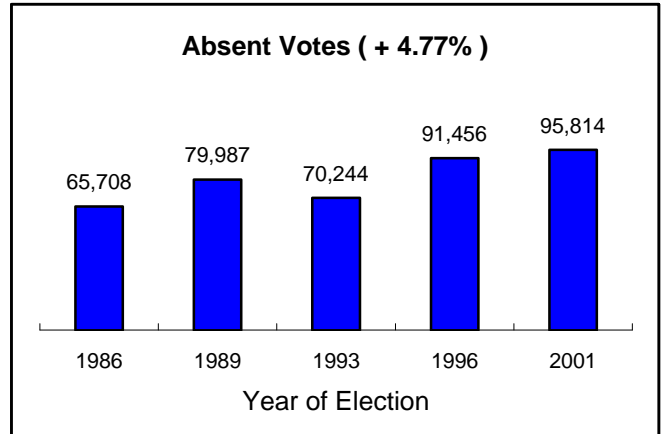
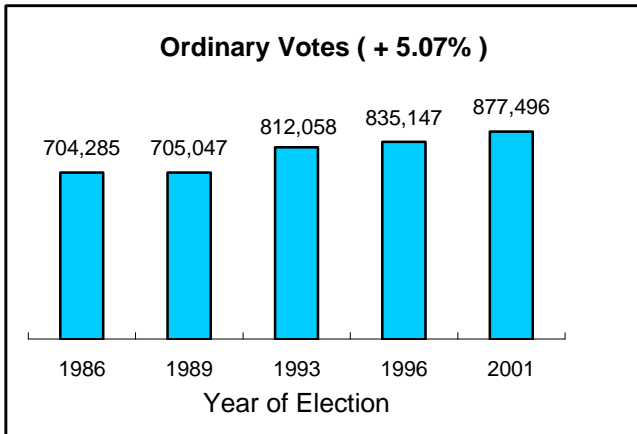

The upward trend for the number of postal and pre-poll votes recorded has continued at this election, an increase of 45.26% compared with 28.14% in 1996. This may be attributed to growing awareness of the convenience of postal voting.

The number of provisional votes recorded has continued to decline at successive elections, a decrease of 32.87% compared with 31.82% in 1996.

The increased percentage of postal and pre-poll votes (1.61%) over the 1996 figure mostly accounts for the 1.28% decrease in ordinary votes.

The number of total valid votes has decreased by 0.15% and the number of informal votes has increased by the same rate.
