Legislative Council Types of Votes by District

The following table shows the types of votes recorded for all districts. The number of votes recorded for a district ranged from a low of 6,962 in the Pilbara district to a high of 35,072 in the Wanneroo district.

On average, 91.4% of the total votes recorded by voters used the ticket preference method when marking their ballot paper. Their vote follows the order of preferences chosen by the group they selected. This represents a decrease of 1.7% from the 1996 State General Election.

Legislative Council Types of Votes by Region - Metropolitan

The following tables show the types of votes recorded for the Legislative Council by metropolitan region and district.

The South Metropolitan Region recorded the greatest percentage of ordinary votes for a region with 83.89%. The North Metropolitan Region recorded the highest percentage of absent votes for a region with 9.37% and the South Metropolitan Region recorded the highest percentage of postal votes with 2.94%. The South Metropolitan Region recorded the greatest percentage of pre-poll votes with 2.66% of the total votes. The North Metropolitan Region recorded the greatest percentage of informal votes with 2.58% of the total votes.

The district of Peel recorded the highest percentage of ordinary votes in a district with 86.48% of the total votes. The Maylands district recorded the highest percentage of absent votes with 13.52%. The district of Yokine recorded the highest percentage of postal votes with 4.31% and the district of Murdoch recorded the highest percentage of pre-poll votes with 4.84%. The highest percentage of informal votes was recorded in the district of Nollamara with 3.47%.

The overall average number of votes recorded for the 34 metropolitan districts was 23,571.

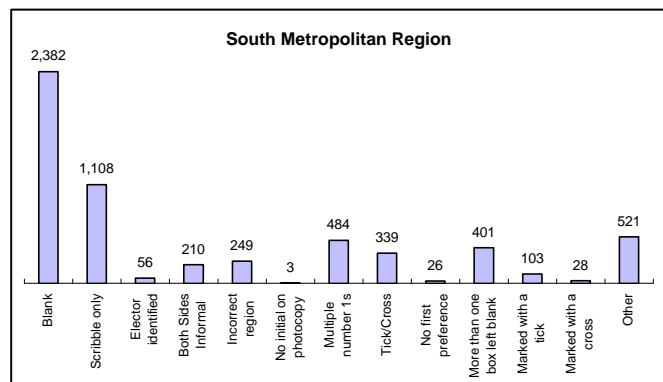
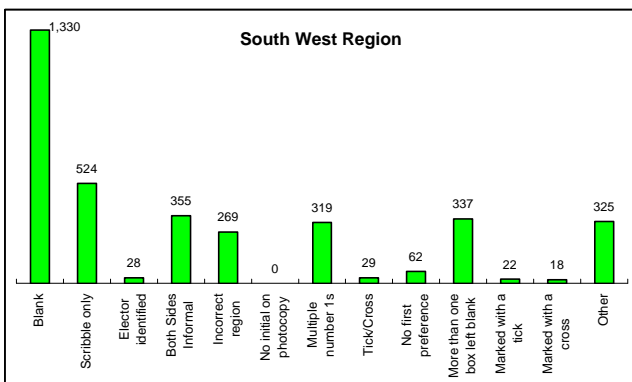
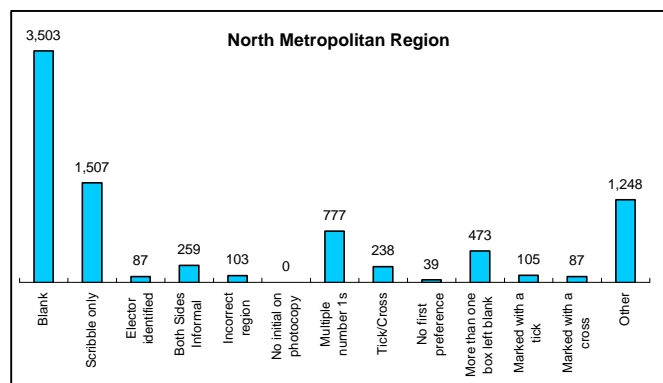
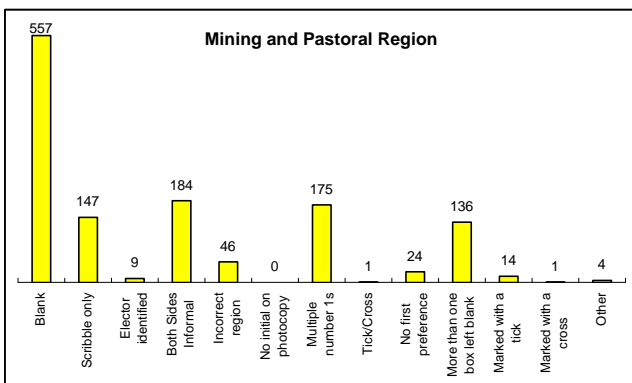
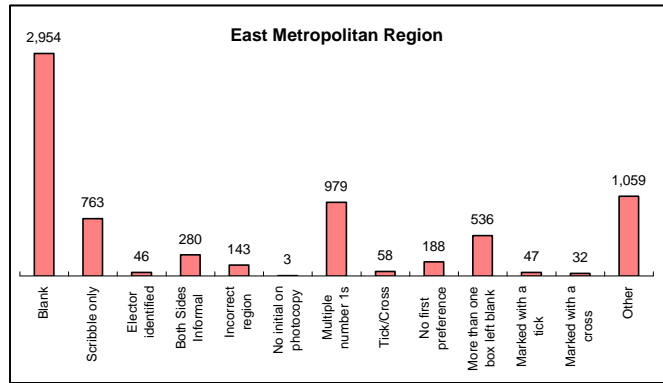
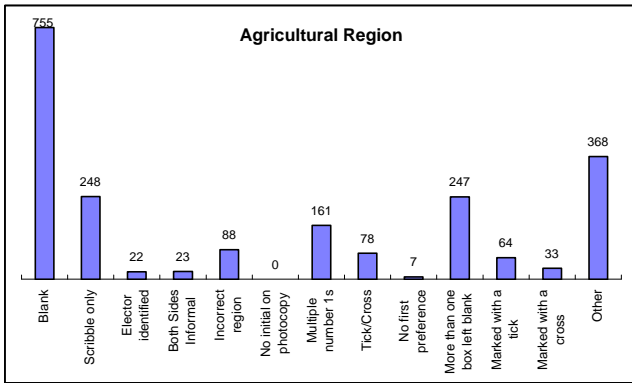
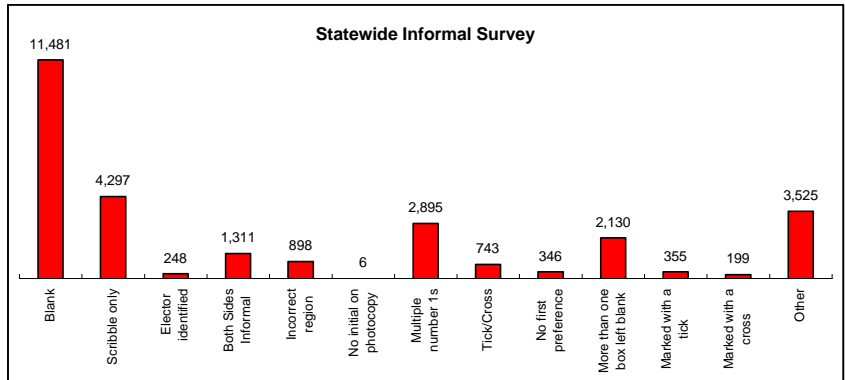
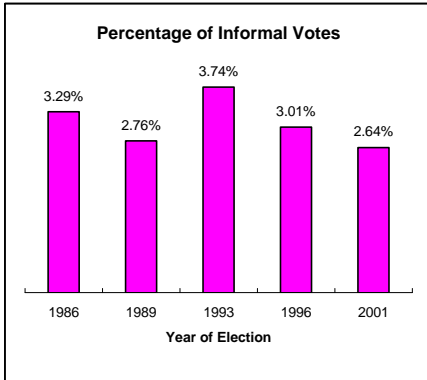
Legislative Council Informal Voting Summary

Informal Voting

Informal voting decreased in the Legislative Council from 3.01% to 2.64% in comparison with the 1996 State General Election.

Ballot papers that are blank, do not show preferences in accordance with instructions and/or legislative requirements, or do not make the voter's intention clear are classified as informal. A ballot paper will also be informal if the voter can be identified through a marking on it. Informal ballot papers do not contribute to the election of a candidate and are not included in calculating the quota or absolute majority required for election.

Blank ballot papers constituted 40% of the informal vote, and ballot papers which were scribbled on comprised 15%, so it would appear that at least 55% of the informal votes were deliberate.

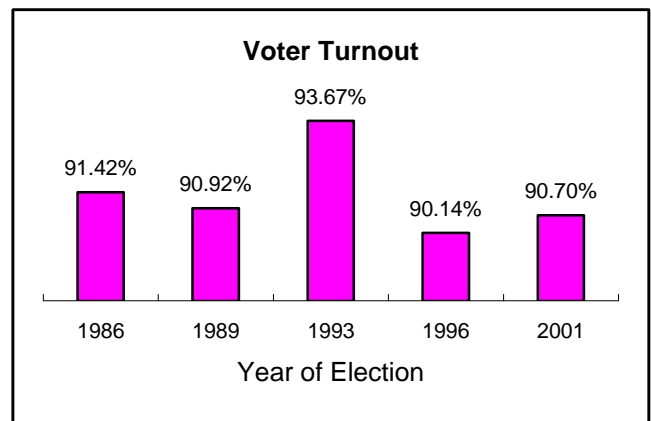
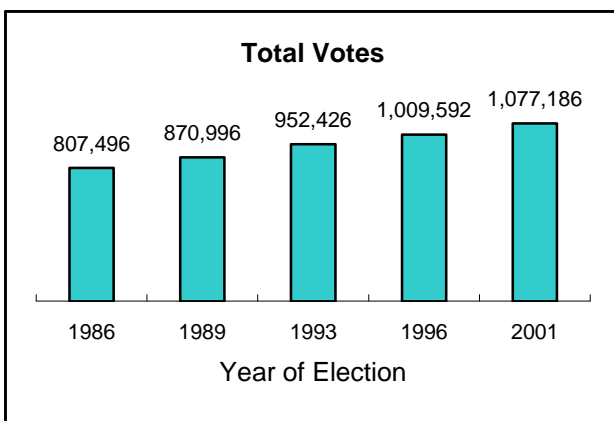
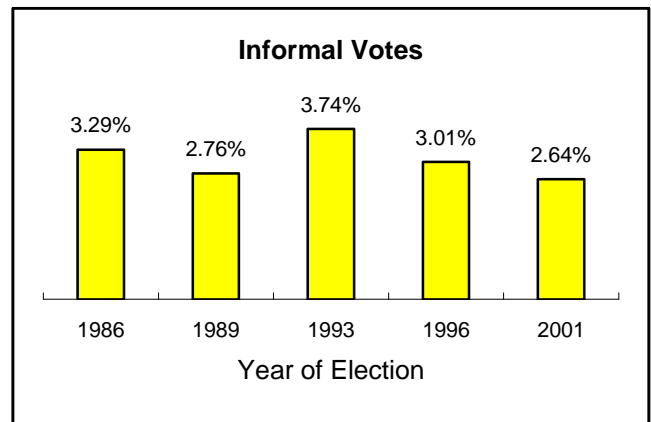
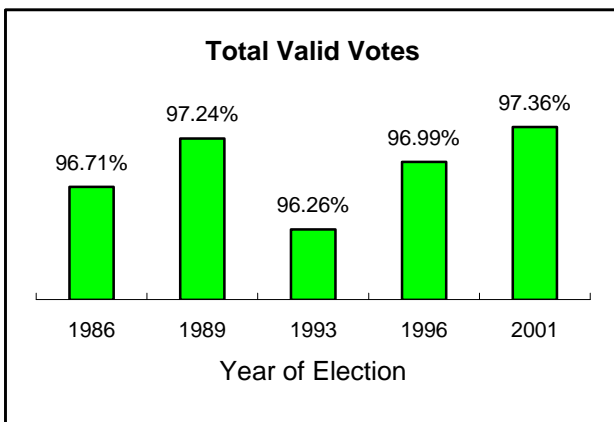
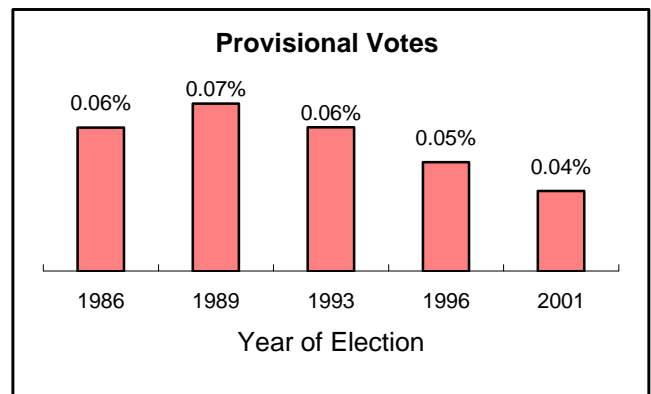
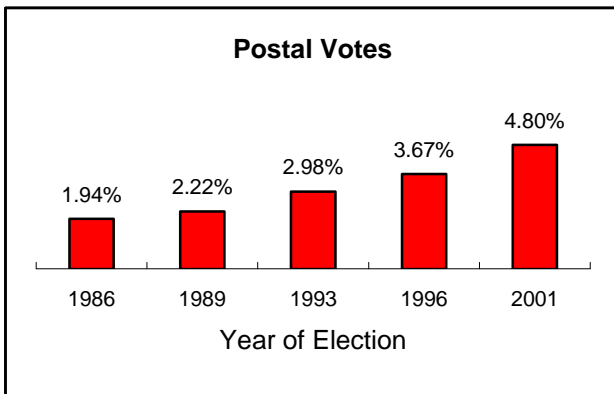
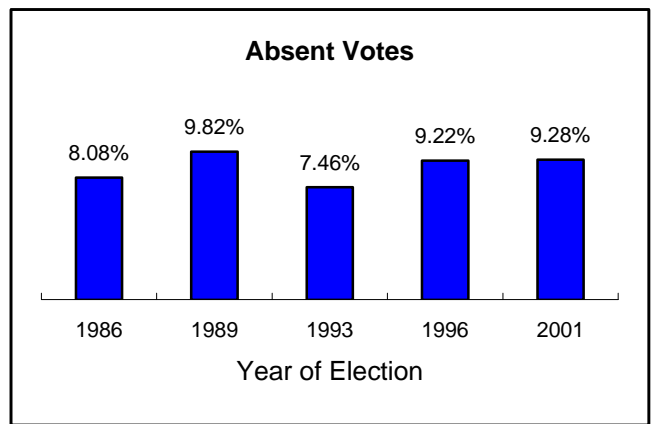
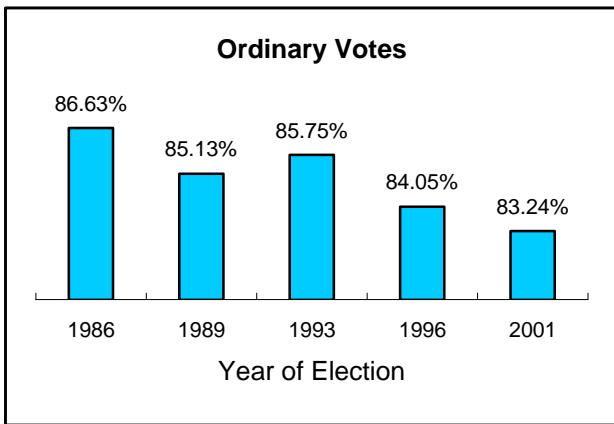
Prior to this election Postal and Pre-Poll figures were aggregated as Postal Votes. While issued separately for the purposes of this election a combined figure is reported to provide for easier comparison with previous elections.

There was a marked increase in the number of Postal votes recorded in 2001. This increase could be due to the increased mobility of electors in the terms of fly-in, fly-out work, domestic and overseas travel and a growing awareness of the availability and convenience of postal voting.
